

A New Probe Of Jackson, Kent Killings

Washington

The American Association of University Professors yesterday announced establishment of a committee to investigate shootings at Kent State University and Jackson State College which claimed six lives.

Robert M. O'Neil, law professor of the University of California at Berkeley, heads the committee appointed by Bertram H. Davis, general secretary of the 85,000-member organization.

Other members are Swarthmore President Robert D. Cross and Professors Raymond Mack of Northwestern and John Morris of Arizona State.

A spokesman said the association's decision to conduct its own investigation did not indicate dissatisfaction with the committee President Nixon has named for the same purpose. But other sources said some members did not feel "too confident" about the Administration investigation.
