

Mother Sues for \$4-Million In Kent State Student Death

CLEVELAND, Aug. 24 (UPI) —The mother of one of the four students killed by National Guardsmen at Kent State University filed a \$4-million damage suit Monday in Federal District Court.

Mrs. Elaine Miller charged in the suit that her son, Jeffrey Glenn Miller, was deprived of his civil rights. She accused Gov. James A. Rhodes, Robert White, Kent State president, and Ohio National Guard officers, including the commander, Gen. Sylvester Del Corso, of negligence. The suit sought \$2-million in compensatory damages and \$2-million in punitive damages.
