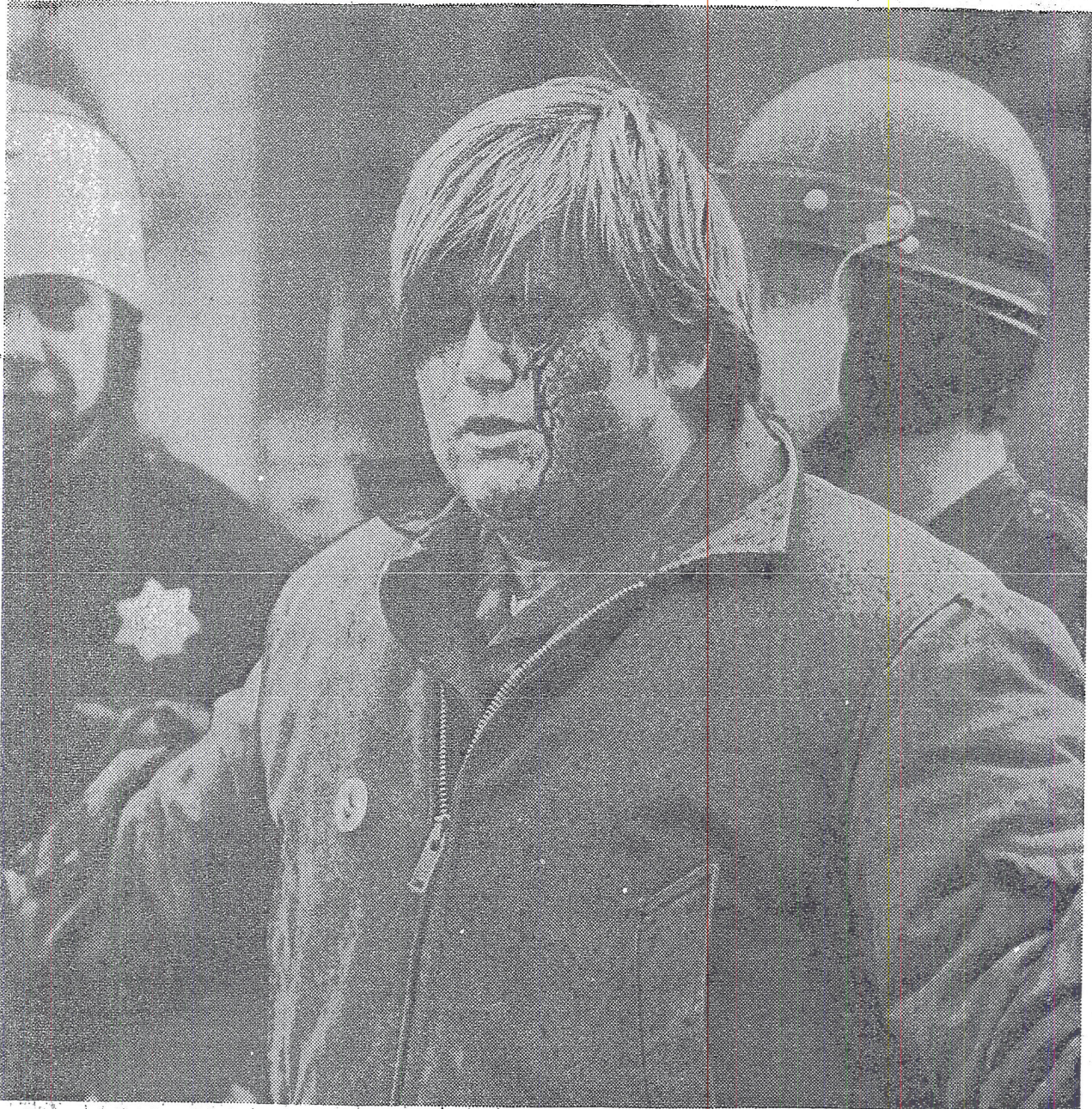
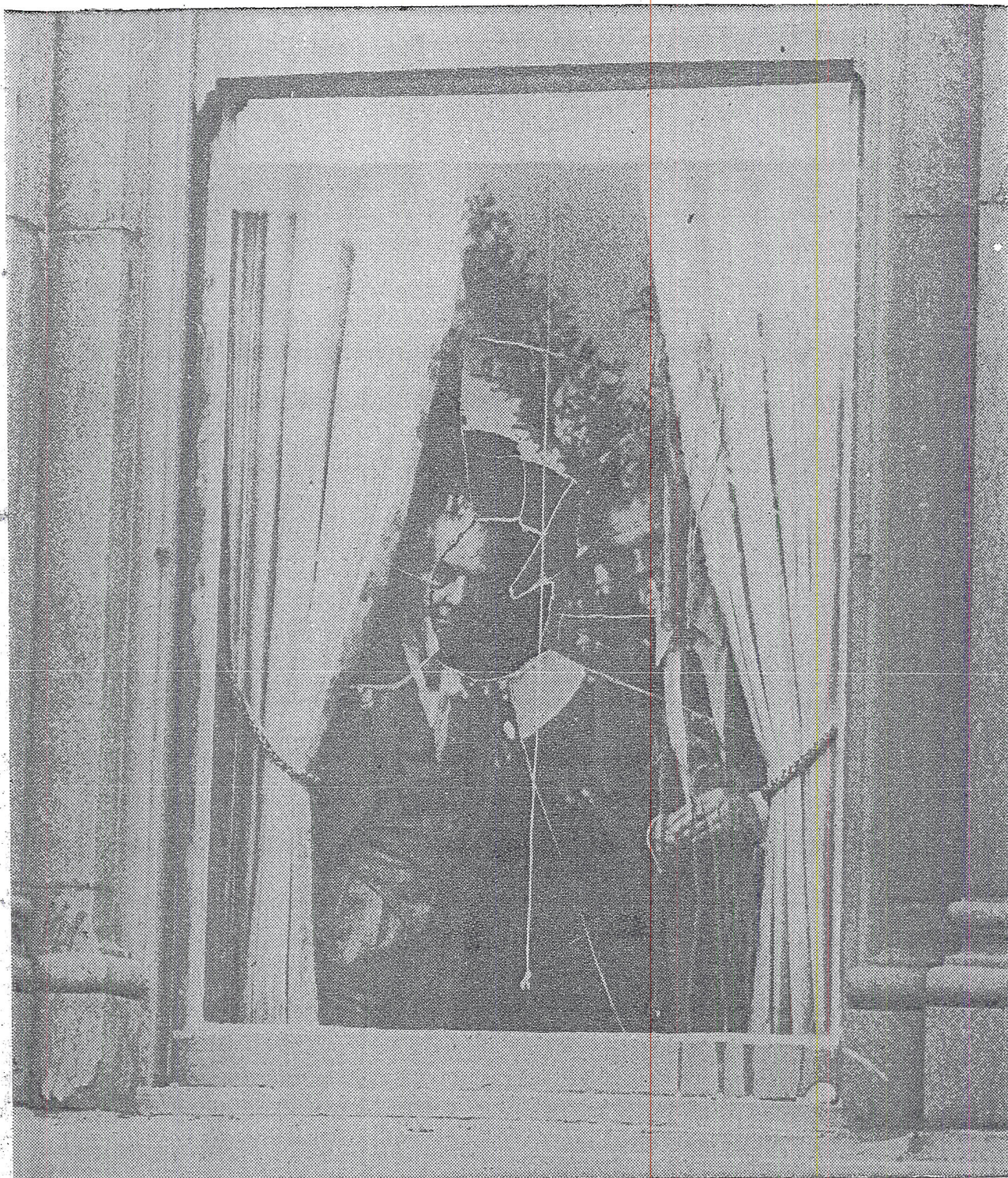


# Battle Ground On Nob Hill

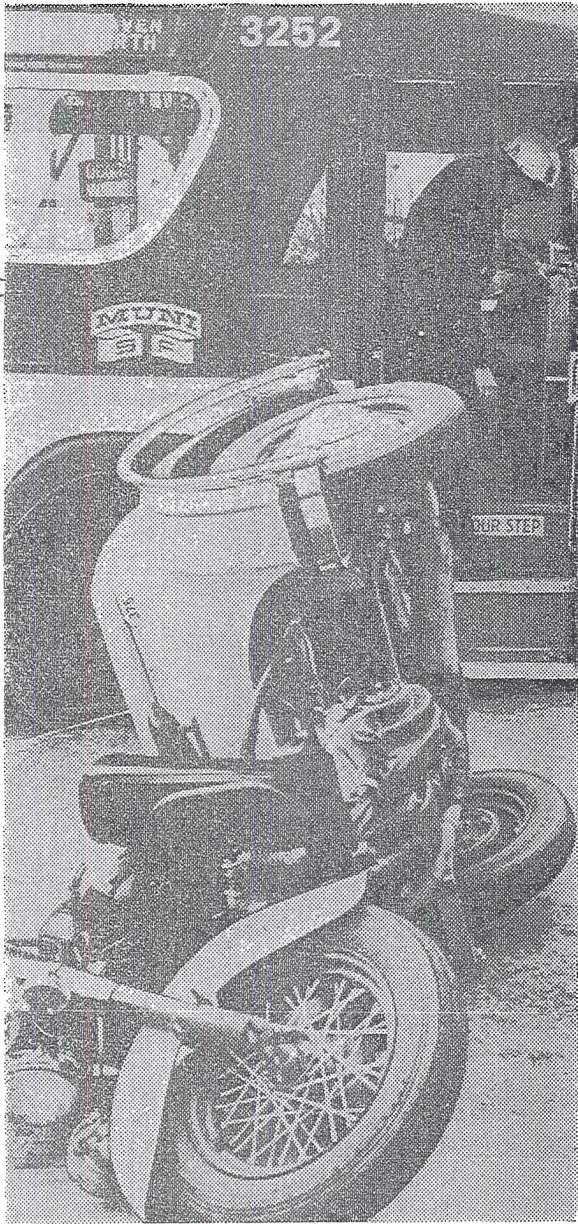


A young man who didn't move fast enough during the battle on Nob Hill bled from a wound made by a policeman's club. The youth was arrested.
