

Thieu Visit Protests Set, Fonda Says

Actress Jane Fonda said yesterday that a coalition of antiwar groups plans a series of demonstrations protesting the arrival in the United States of South Vietnam President Nguyen Van Thieu.

Miss Fonda said the first demonstrations will be held in Los Angeles Saturday at 6 p.m. at the Beverly Hilton Hotel and will be followed with a demonstration Sunday at the same time at San Clemente State Park, adjacent to President Nixon's west coast home.

The San Clemente demonstration will be an all-night vigil before Thieu's arrival in the U.S. Monday, she said. The demonstration scene will shift at noon Monday at the Western White House.

Speaking to a student group at Fresno State University. Miss Fonda said, "Nixon is trying to make real the Thieu government. He's doing so by bringing Thieu to the United States next week."

"It is unconscionable to think that money we need here is going to the Thieu government," she said.
