

### ***Nixon, Leaving Church, Encounters Protesters***

WASHINGTON, April 9 (AP)—President Nixon drove a block away from the White House today to attend afternoon services at historic St. John's Episcopal Church and, on emerging, encountered a sprinkling of noisy antiwar demonstrators.

Mr. Nixon and the church's senior warden, Philip Watts, an investment banker who is an old acquaintance, sat almost unnoticed in a ninth-row pew of the 155-year-old church across Lafayette Park from the White House.

The President, who attended the final 15 minutes of a noon-to-3 P.M. Good Friday service, stepped out toward his car and ignored chants of "Christ died for all men" and "Peace now" from a handful of demonstrators.
