

Los Angeles Council Urges Vietnam Pullout

LOS ANGELES, Sept. 8—
The Los Angeles City Council passed today a resolution urging the withdrawal of all American troops from Vietnam by the end of the year.

The resolution, which was adopted unanimously by the legislative body of the nation's third-largest city, also paid tribute to President Nixon's efforts to bring the war to an end and appealed for action to obtain the release of United States prisoners.

The resolution said that "to achieve immediately the start of release of American prisoners of war and those missing in action, the President [should] remove all American troops from Indochina by Dec. 31, 1971."

Mayor Samuel W. Yorty denounced the action as "just playing politics."
