# Pot, Heroin Charges

## Swat GI Unit

SAIGON — (UPI) — Almost one-third of a U.S. Army road-building company faces narcotics charges, military spokesmen said today.

Forty-three of the 150 GIs in "B" company, 169th Engineering Battalion, were detained for using heroin and marijuana at a small base camp known as "Castle in the Sky" on Highway 20 about 65 miles northeast of Saigon.

Eight Army criminal investigation division agents

posing as drug users infiltrated the company three weeks before the big cleanup raid was made last Friday. Details of the incident were not released by the U.S. Command but confirmed after UPI learned of the raid.

Between 70 and 80 vials of heroin, a large quantity of marijuana and equipment used in taking drugs were seized in the raid, spokesmen said.

Three of the 43 servicemen were suspected of selling narcotics, they said.
