

U.S. Court Orders Refund Of War Protesters' Bond

WASHINGTON, Oct. 2 (UPI) —The United States Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia has ordered the District to refund collateral forfeited by many of the 12,000 persons arrested during the Mayday antiwar demonstrations.

The order, issued Friday night, also told the District to take steps to insure that Mayday arrest records were not circulated, even to the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

The American Civil Liberties Union had brought the action in behalf of the arrested demonstrators who participated in the protests between April 28 and May 5.
