

Anti-War Petition By GIs in Vietnam

Saigon

A group of American soldiers is circulating a petition among other United States troops in Vietnam calling on Congress to take action for "an immediate cessation of all hostilities in Southeast Asia," a spokesman for the group said yesterday.

The spokesman for Vietnam Veterans Against the War said more than 400 servicemen from all branches of the armed forces already have signed the petition.

The spokesman, James Mohler, 24, a Navy enlisted man from Cuyahoga Falls, Ohio, said the group's origi-

nal goal was 2000 signatures but that response had been such that it probably would get considerably more.

The petition campaign is believed to be the first of its kind conducted by U.S. troops among their own forces in Vietnam.
