

# A Banker's Warning

A New York banker told Associated Press yesterday it may be necessary to install electronic metal - detecting devices to prevent the bombing of safe deposit box areas.

Though bankers in most communities, including San

Francisco, would not discuss their ideas for possible security improvements, a spokesman for Marine Midland Bank-New York said customers may be asked to pass through electronic barriers on their way to bank vaults.

The devices would be simi-

lar to those installed at airports in an effort to preventing hijacking of aircraft.

The New York Clearing House said representatives of the 11 big banks doing business in the city would meet soon to discuss security.
