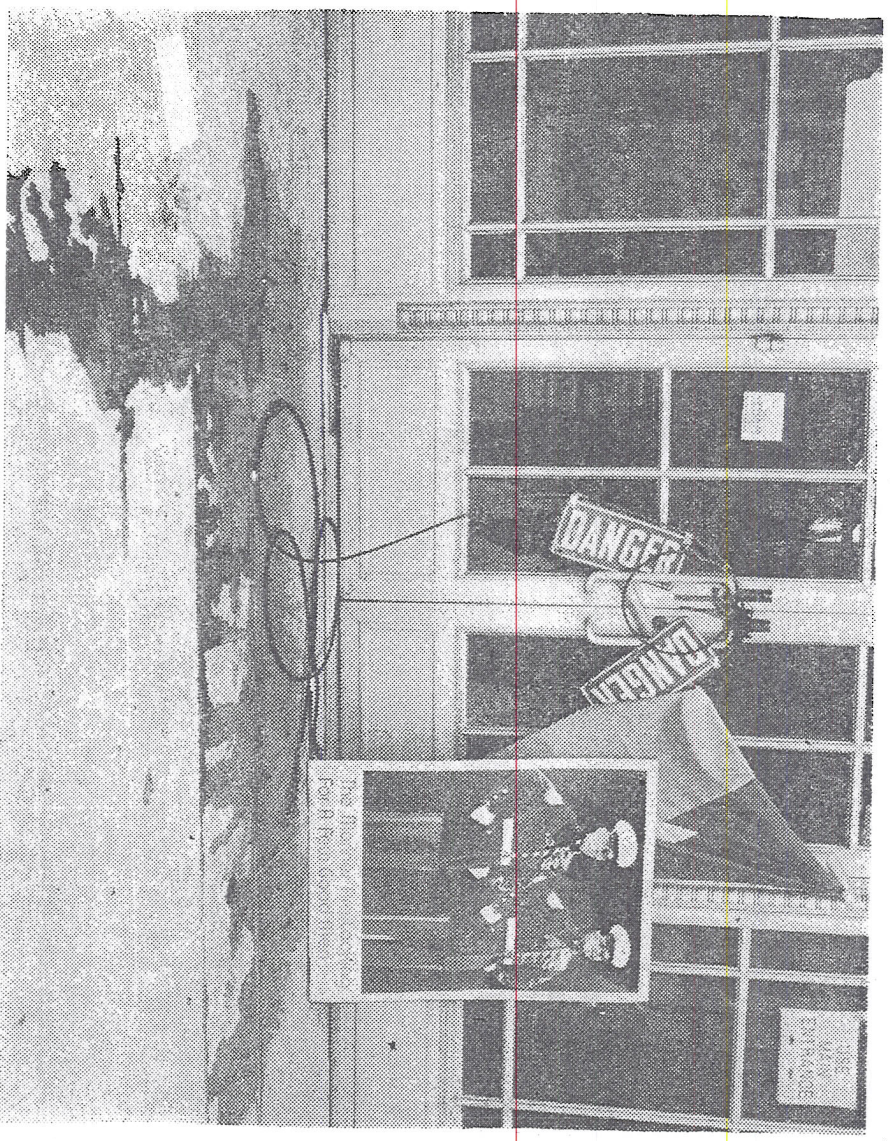


'Blood' And Fire In S.F.

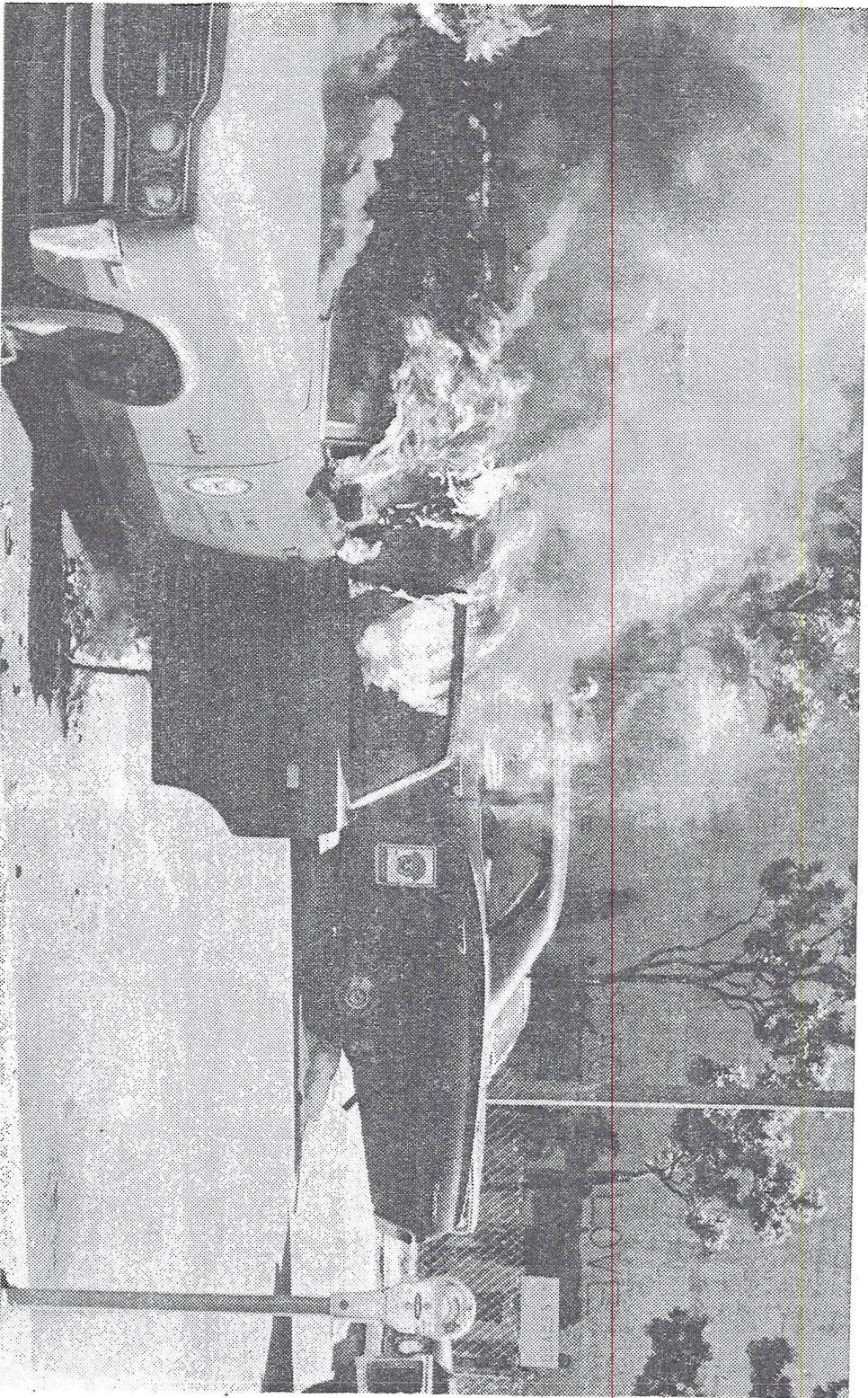


'Blood' was poured on the sidewalk at Fulton and Leavenworth
