Anti-War Mass in Pentagon

Washington

With altar and Bibles provided by the Pentagon, three Episcopal bishops conducted an hour - long mass inside the defense Department yesterday to protest the Vietnam war.

It was the first anti-war protest permitted within the building under a recent court ruling barring the government from interfering with public meetings that oppose its policies.

"Our presence in the Pentagon today symbolizes the only options left to mankind: to live together as brothers or to die together as fools," the Right Rev. C. Edward Crowther told more than 100 worshippers who sang and prayed for peace.
