

New Inquiry on Kent State Urged by Victims' Parents

WASHINGTON, Oct. 14 (AP) —Parents of four Kent State University students killed by National guardsmen two years ago have asked a Federal court to order the investigation into the shooting reopened.

Lawyers for the parents and other victims are asking for a grand jury inquiry which former Attorney General John N. Mitchell refused to begin more than a year ago.

Plaintiffs in the suit include Arthur Krause of Pittsburgh, father of Allison Krause; Lewis Schroeder, father of William Schroeder; Sarah Scheuer, mother of Sandy Scheuer; and Elaine Miller, mother of Jesse Miller.
