

**Richardson May Reopen
Kent State Investigation**

WASHINGTON, June 13 (UPI)—Attorney General Elliot L. Richardson said Wednesday the Justice Department might reopen the inquiry into the Ohio National Guard confrontation at Kent State University that resulted in four student deaths during 1970 antiwar demonstrations.

“Assistant Attorney General J. Stanley Pottinger is taking a fresh look at the Kent State University issue to determine whether or not the decision not to convene a grand jury was properly founded. I will let you know the results of the department’s review,” Mr. Richardson wrote Kent State President Glenn A. Olds.
