Prayer Protest Arrests

Washington

Fourteen persons were arrested in three separate incidents at the White House as they held prayer vigils in the public tour lines yesterday.

There was a continuation of anti-war protests that have been going on for weeks at the presidential mansion, resulting in a total of more than 80 arrests.

The incidents occurred yesterday morning within about 20 minutes of each other.

Two of the protesters had to be carried away by police. All were charged with unlawful entry, although the incidents occurred in the tour line outside the East entrance to the White House itself.
