Capital Bomb Protest

WASHINGTON — (UPI) — Sister Elizabeth McAlister, wife of antiwar priest Philip Berrigan, and three other women were arrested yesterday for demonstrating at the White House against the continued U.S. bombing of Cambodia.

Authorities said the demonstrators, three nuns and another woman were arrested when they broke from a tour line and began praying.

Sister McAlister, 33, Baltimore, was one of the defendants along with Berrigan in the conspiracy trial of the Harrisburg Seven. Police

identified the others arrested as Sister Carole Lombard, 34, Weymouth, Mass.; Sister Patricia Keefe, 41, Weymouth, Mass., and Maureen Carey, 29, Hanover, Mass.

Their arrests brought to 98 the number of persons taken into custody since the demonstrations began July 6.

The Community for Creative Non-violence, which coordinates the protests, said it plans a national day of civil disobedience for Aug. 14, one day before the bombing is scheduled to stop.
