

## **Javits' Prediction on Pullout**

### **New York**

Sen. Jacob K. Javits, (Rep-N.Y.) said yesterday he expects President Nixon to announce November 1 that Vietnamization has been realized and American forces will leave South Vietnam quickly.

Javits said in a broadcast interview that factors influencing Mr. Nixon would include various votes and amendments in the Senate on resolutions and amendments dealing with the Indochina war, the general dissatisfaction in the nation and publi-

cation of the Pentagon papers.

They will "induce the President to announce November 1 that Vietnamization has been completed and that we are getting out just as rapidly as our troops and material can be redeployed," Javits said.

Javits said the date would be November 1 because Nixon has said he will make a "definitive announcement upon the whole question" at that time.

He said he was "deeply convinced that we ought to

fix a date for our withdrawal." adding that the North Vietnamese have said they would begin to release prisoners when a date was set.

Javits spoke on the WABC Radio Press Conference.
