

Blast From Peking

HONG KONG — (UPI) — China, in its first major verbal attack on the United States since President Nixon's visit, said today that despite continued bombing of North Vietnam, American policy is doomed to failure here.

"U.S. imperialists should stop all the military actions against the people in Indochina and withdraw all their troops and troops of their allies from the area," said

a statement by the Chinese Foreign Ministry.

The statement said "the U.S. air bombing will not scare the people in Vietnam and countries in Indochina."

It said that despite worldwide opposition, the United States "obdurately persists in carrying out wanton bombing" of North Vietnam.

"The so-called 'air and naval superiority' the United States had been bragging about for many years has long failed to work," it added.
