

## Lon Nol Announces Formation Of New Cambodian Government

PNOMPENH, Cambodia, March 21 (UPI)—President Lon Nol announced the formation of a new government tonight. San Ngoc Thanah, an elder statesman and presidential adviser, was named Premier and Foreign Minister.

The announcement on the national radio came eight after the resignation of Premier-delegate Sisowath Sirik Matak and his Cabinet in the present government crisis. Yesterday, the new cabinet was made known on the national radio, which described the list of members as professional.

Protesting students, who continued their activities today

despite a severe rocket attack on Pnompenh, were expected to continue their demonstrations calling for "more new men" in the Government. The students indicated they were content with the choice of the new Premier.

Of the 17 ministers named, eight were old faces and most of them well-known officials.

Mr. Sirik Matak was not named to any position—apparently a concession to the students. Three of the ministers are career military men.

President Lon Nol also said he was setting up a government commission to finish preparing a new constitution.
