

Clark Arrives in Hanoi During Air Raid Alerts

HANOI, North Vietnam, July 29 (Agence France-Presse) — Ramsey Clark, former United States Attorney General, arrived here today from Moscow on a two-week visit as guest of the North Vietnamese Government.

Mr. Clark is a member of an international committee that is to investigate the effects of American bombing of areas inhabited by civilians and especially damage to dikes.

The commission arrived here during air raid alerts after a period of calm that had lasted for several days.

The members wore protective helmets as they went to their hotel.

During the alerts, a number of explosions were heard in the eastern suburbs.

Material on Clark also filed POWs.
