

# *She Survives Napalm*



Two months ago Phan Thi Kim Phuc was photographed as she fled screaming and naked down a road near Saigon with other children after she had been severely burned when South Vietnamese planes accidentally dropped napalm on them. Today, Kim Phuc, right, is recovering, although still showing hideous scars, and is well enough to push another young patient in a wheelchair at the Barsky Center, a hospital for plastic and reconstructive surgery in Saigon. More than 50 children and adults are being treated there. Kim Phuc is "one of the least serious cases here," said one surgeon, "and she will be going home soon."
