## Green Beret Troops Are Leaving Thailand

Bangkok

The U.S. will withdraw 300 Green Beret troops from Thailand by March 31, leaving only about two dozen behind, U.S. officials said yesterday.

The Green Berets, have been involved in a counterinsurgency training program in Thailand, U.S. and Thai government spokesmen reported that the 300 U.S. Special Forces troops have been training Thai, Cambodian and Laotian soldiers.

The remaining Green Berets will stay behind to wind up the program, which dates to 1960, and to dispose of U.S. military property, an American spokesman said.

The pullout will have eight effect on over-all American troop strength of 05 000 in Thailand, U.S. spokesmen said. This has

dropped by about 7500 in the st year.
