

Presidential Orders Missing From Register

Washington, July 11 (AP) - Presidential directives dealing with major steps in United States military involvement in the Vietnam war are missing from the Federal Register, the staff of a Senate committee says.

The Federal Register Act of 1935 requires publication of Presidential proclamations or executive orders that involve compliance by individuals or the spending of public funds. The rules permit recording of secret or classified orders by numerical suffix only.

The gaps in the Government record of Presidential decisions and orders were discovered by the Senate Special Committee on National Emergencies.
