

Thai Teenagers Given Death in Official's Slaying

Phnom Penh

A military tribunal has sentenced two high school students to death and ordered long prison terms for ten others in connection with the deaths of Cambodia's education minister and his top aide, press reports said yesterday.

The students were convicted on charges of complicity in the deaths of Education Minister Keo Sang Kim and his assistant, Tach Thia, in a wild demonstration at a school on June 4.

Scores of students and military police were injured in the demonstration.
