Mr. and Mrs. Lawrence Goff, undercover agents for the FBI who had infiltrated the San Jose Revolutionary Union, testified before House Internal Security Committee about demonstration against Nixon in San Jose 17 Oct 70.

In story the following day Chris Menchine, spokesman for the San Jose Revolutionary Union, said Goff was the greatest advocate of violence in the organization. "That guy even suggested we get some mustard gas and use it to force the (military) recruiters out of the San Jose State (College) student union."
