

Dr. King Medal Proposed

WASHINGTON, March 26 (AP)

—A special national medal honoring the late Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. for his civil rights activity would be struck under terms of a bill entered in the House today. Representative Margaret M. Heckler, Republican of Massachusetts, and 32 co-sponsors introduced the measure to present a gold medal to Dr. King's widow and make available duplicates in bronze for use of memorial organizations in fund-raising activities.
