The Department of Justice's investigation of the FBI harassment campaign against Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., has uncovered no evidence that the FBI caused King's death, either directly or indirectly, a department official says.

The official, who asked to remain anonymous, said that the review, ordered last month by Attorney General Edward H. Levi, is about one-fifth completed.
