**Ray's Lawyer Seeks to Quit**

MEMPHIS, May 24 (UPI)— Bernard Fensterwald, chief counsel for James Earl Ray, has asked the United States Court of Appeals for the Sixth Circuit to allow him to withdraw from Mr. Ray's long legal fight to be tried on charges of assassinating the Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Mr. Ray's local counsel, Robert I. Livingston, said Monday that he had learned that Mr. Ray had asked Mr. Fensterwald to withdraw.
