Dita Beard was arrested for drunken driving in San Diego last August and thrown in jail, but according to the paper she was bailed out by the president of Tolla [? - phonetic] Company, an advertising firm which lists Republican Representative Bob Wilson as a vice-president. Mr. Wilson is chairman of the Republican Congressional Committee and according to The Union was instrumental in bringing the Republican convention to San Diego.

The president of the advertising firm, Norman Tolla, said Mr. Wilson was unaware of the arrest. He said Mrs. Beard was a frequent visitor to San Diego and often dined at his home. The Union reported that Mr. Tolla said that Mrs. Beard was in San Diego for an I. T. & T. stockholders' meeting last May. It was at that meeting that Representative Wilson says the president of I.T. & T., Harold Geneen, offered up to \$400,000 to underwirte the cost of the Republican convention.
