## Martha Backs Raids

CHICAGO — (AP) — “Everybody should rise up and say, ‘Think you, Mr. President, for bombing Hai-phong,’” Martha Mitchell says.

The reference to recent U.S. bombings of North Vietnam was made by the wife of former Attorney General John N. Mitchell in an address last night to the Midwest Regional Republican Women’s Conference.

She also told the 700 Republican women, “It looks like it will be impossible to get the auditorium in San

Diego ready in time for the Republican National Convention.”

There has been no official word to that effect from her husband, who resigned from the Nixon cabinet to manage the President’s 1972 campaign. There has been speculation that the convention might be moved to Miami Beach, Fla.

On no longer being a member of the cabinet family, the outspoken Mrs. Mitchell said, “I’m now a free citizen, and it’s wonderful.”
