Head of House Unit Bids Nixon Delay Secrecy Rule

-Nixon Delay Secrecy Rule WASHINGTON, May 3 (AP) -The head of a House sub-dommittee investigating Gov-eriment secrecy asked Presi-dent Nixon today to postpone indefinitely the June 1 effec-tive date of a new Executive order on the classification of documents. "Its inherent defects and the lack of adequate time to fully implement it make it im-perative," said Representative William S. Moorhead, Demo-crat of Pennsylvania, that Mr. Nixon "act promptly to pre-vent further chaotic conditions that could adversely affect our national defense and foreign policy." Mr. Moorhead, chairman of the House Government Infor-mation Subcommittee, said that a delay would give Congress a chance to consider a statutory alternative that he plans to in-troduce.
