

City Reported Under Repair

BANGKOK, May 16 (Reuters) —After forcing millions of people out of Phnom Penh, Cambodia's rulers are now repairing the city's airport and other facilities "so that the town can become active again," radio Phnom Penh said today.

The radio indicated that people had already been moved from the countryside into the city, which had been evacuated after the communist take-over a month ago.
