Calley Starts Defense Fund At Bank in Columbus, Ga. COLUMBUS, Ga., Dec. 20 (AP)—First Lieut. William L. Calley Jr. has opened a bank account here to handle contributions made to his defense. Bank officials said Lieutenant Calley had personally opened the "William L. Calley Defense Fund" account during the week. Lieutenant Calley faces trial by court-martial on charges of murdering 109 civillans at the village of Songmy in March, 1968. No date has been set for the trial. vilian about six weeks earlier, but has not been ordered to trial on that charge. The bank source said Lieutenant Calley had received a small, unsolicited donation to his defense and he felt "it needed to be handled in a formal man-

ner."
