"Mr. Ziegler said that the President's order was 'not a legal step.' When questioned, he said that Mr. Mixon was aware of the pro-Calley sentiment throughout the country that has been expressed in thousands of telegrams to the White House. But Mr. Ziegler said that the action 'was taken at the President's own initiative.'"

The order, Mr. Ziegler said, was relayed by Admiral Moorer to Lieut. Gen. Albert O. Connor, commander of the Third Army, at Fort Benning. Mr. Nixon, he said, acted not in his capacity as Commander in Chief, but as President.
