

Mrs. Mitchell's Press Aide To Take Job in Colorado

WASHINGTON, June, 8—William Woestendiek, the television news editor here who was dismissed last April when his wife took a job as press secretary to the wife of Attorney General John N. Mitchell, will be named editor of The Colorado Springs Sun tomorrow.

H. M. Greenspun, publisher of the Colorado newspaper and

of the Las Vegas Sun, said today that Mr. Woestendiek would get a share of ownership in the enterprise and that his wife, Kay, would be hired as women's editor of The Colorado Springs Sun.

Mrs. Mitchell, whose attacks on critics of the Nixon Administration have been tempered in the weeks since Mrs. Woestendiek went to work for her, will preside at a news conference here tomorrow announcing the Woestendieks' new jobs.
