

Chotiner's Estranged Wife Sues for Divorce on Coast

SANTA ANA, Calif., Dec. 10 (AP)—The estranged wife of Murray Chotiner asked Friday for a divorce.

Analia Chotiner, 44 years old, asked Superior Court Judge Samuel Dreizen to dissolve her five-year marriage to the adviser to President Nixon on the ground of "extreme incompatibility."

Mrs. Chotiner told newsmen before the divorce hearing, which is expected to last several days, that she was writing a book about her husband's work as "hatchet man" for the President.

She said that the book would detail the President's "secret maneuvers in national and California politics and spell out Chotiner's role in all that wheeling and dealing."

Asked about the book, Mr. Chotiner said he "didn't know what his wife could possibly write about."
