

Black Caucus of House To See Nixon Thursday

WASHINGTON, March 22 (UPI)—The White House said today that President Nixon would meet Thursday with 12 Negro members of the House — a meeting the so-called "black caucus" has been seeking for nearly a year.

The group boycotted Mr. Nixon's State of the Union message on Jan. 22. Mr. Nixon said at a news conference in February that he hoped a meeting could be worked out, and two weeks ago the White House announced that one had been tentatively scheduled.

All of the black House members are Democrats. Senator Edward W. Brooke, Massachusetts Republican who is the only black in the Senate, is not a member of the caucus.
