AGNEW, IN NAIROBI, SEES KENYAN LEADER

NAIROBI, Kenya, July 13-Vice President Agnew met in-formally here today with Kenya's President, Jomo Ken-vatta

The principal purpose of the session, they added, was to ex-change assurances of continued and relations between the two good relations between the two countries.

countries. Mr. Agnew planned to spend part of the night observing lo-cal game from a lounge at Treetops, a hotel built among trees and on wooden pilings about two hours drive from here. He is to return to Nai-robi tomorrow. He leaves for Kinshasa, the Congo, Thurs-day on the next leg of his 10-nation goodwill tour, which be-gan June 27. At luncheon today Mr.

At luncheon today Mr. Agnew gave Mr. Kenyatta a replica of a lamp used by George Washington—the orig-inal is in the Smithsonian In-stitution in Washington—and in return received an ankle-length fur cape typical of those worn by elders of the Kikuyu tribe, a foot-long carved wooden rhinoceros and a carved wooden elephant.
