

**Democrats See Agnew Trip
As Sign Nixon Will Drop Him**

WASHINGTON, July 15 (AP) —The Democratic National Committee has described Vice President Agnew's 10-nation goodwill tour as a meaningless mission that indicates President Nixon will drop him from the Republican ticket in 1972.

But the chairman of the Republican National Committee, Robert J. Dole, said in an interview that he had seen no evidence of any change in the make-up of the ticket for 1972.

Mr. Dole said that he did not know the specific purpose of Mr. Agnew's trip around the world. "There must have been one," he said. "I'm sure there was."
