'Nixon Trip To Hanoi In Works'

LONDON — (UPI) — The London Observer said in its Sunday editions President Nixon may visit Hanoi after his visit to Peking. The Observer quoted "well informed Romanian sources."

In a front page report by Lajos Lederer the Observer said Nixon "has offered to have direct talks with the North Vietnam leaders to speed up a settlement of the Vietnam war and if the offer is accepted, he may visit Hanoi after his stay in Peking."

It said last month Romanian President Nicolae Ceausescu passed on White House proposals for better relations during a visit to Peking and Hanoi.

"The sources in Bucharest say that further high-level talks between China and the United States may take place before President Nixon's journey to Peking. They will probably be held in the autumn, when Chinese Premier Chou En-lai comes to Europe, and before a final decision is taken at the United Nations about China's admission," it said.
