**G.O.P. Group Censures  
Nixon on Trip to China**

ANAHEIM, Calif., July 27 (UPI)—The Orange County chapter of the California Republican Assembly, the oldest party volunteer organization in the state, has voted to censure President Nixon for "betrayal of principles" in his decision to visit Communist China.

The organization, which has about 15,000 members in Orange County—Mr. Nixon's birthplace — voted on the motion yesterday.

Tom Rogers, chairman of the Orange County Republican Central Committee, said the committee did not agree with the action.

"My own personal opinion reflects that of Governor [Ronald] Regan and Senator [Barry] Goldwater in supporting the President," Mr. Rogers said.
