WASHINGTON, Oct. 14—
President Nixon, who has made the fight against cancer a major point in his domestic program, will go to Fort Detrick, Md., Monday to announce the conversion of the Army biological warfare research center there to a cancer recearch center there to a cancer recearch center there to a cancer recearch center.

A White House spokesman confirmed Thursday the President's plans to go to Fort Detrick but refused to disclose the purpose of the visit. Other Administration officials, however, acknowledged that the center, considered one of the nation's facilities for virus studies, was to be converted to cancer research.
