Dinners at 14c a Plate

SACRAMENTO — (UPI) — The California Welfare Rights Organization says it will stage 14-cent-a-plate, rice and tea dinners to coincide with President Nixon's \$500-a-plate campaign "fund raisers" Nov 9.

Mrs. Catherine Jermany, head of the group, said the dinners will be billed as a "Salute to the Poor" in contrast to the "Salute to the President" 'dinners for Nixon.

"We hope to kick off Mr. "We hope to kick off Mr. Nixon's 1972 campaign." Mrs. Jermany said. "We hope to kick it clear off the track."

The Sacramento woman said both types of dinners will be held in Los Angeles, San Diego and San Francisco. In Los Angeles, she said, both groups will be dining at the Beverly Wilshire.

Protest dinners were also scheduled here and in other California cities.
