White House Concedes Nixon Spoke to Powell

Nixon Spoke to Powell WASHINGTON, Nov. 2 (AP)—The White House acknowledged today that President Nixon had talked with Lewis F. Powell Jr. sev-eral days before announcing his nomination to the Su-preme Court. But a spokes. man said hat Mr. Powell was not asked specifically to ac-cept the nomination until the day Mr. Nixon announced it. A special American Bar Association report yesterday said Attorney General John N. Michell had offered the nomination to Mr. Powell, a Richmond, Va., attorney, be-fore the bar group had found that the Administration's two top candidates for the court were unqualified."
