Hartke Says Kissinger Deserves to Be Ousted

—Senator Vance Hartke, Democrat of Indiana, said today in an interview that Henry A. Kissinger, President Nixon's foreign affairs adviser, had assumed powers that were not his and should be dismissed.

Mr. Hartke, who is campaigning in next Tuesday's Presidential primary, said Mr. Kissinger's role in the Nixon administration "is an example of what's wrong about our Government."
