Justices to Weigh U.S. Secrecy Role

Will Hear Plea on Extent of Government Authority
to Bar Reports From Public

Washington, March 6 - The Supreme Court agreed today to rule on the scope of the Government's authority to classify documents as secret and keep them from Congress and the public.

The case concerns nine reports and letters prepared for President Nixon in advance of an underground nuclear test [Camikin] that was held last year in Alaska.
