Mitchell Back At Old Nixon N. Y. Law Firm

John N. Mitchell, attorney general until March 1, has rejoined the New York law firm in which he and President Nixon were partners before the 1968 election.

Sources close to the law firm said yesterday that Mitchell will draw a salary from it — although not that of a full senior partner — while he is heading Mr. Nixon's campaign for re-election this year.

Mitchell's name will not be put back into the name of the firm, however. It will continue to be known as Mudge Rose Guthrie & Alexander.
