Mitchell Takes Post In Campaign

Former Attorney General John N. Mitchell, who managed President Nixon's 1968 campaign, became director yesterday of the Committee for the Re-Election of the President.

Mitchell served as attorney general from Jan. 21, 1969 until he resigned to manage the President's 1972 re-election effort.

"I am proud to assist in the re-election effort of President Nixon, whom I am confident is one of the greatest presidents in American history," Mitchell said in a statement.
