**Kissinger Aide Is in Danang
To Assess Military Outlook**

DANANG, South Vietnam, April 17 (Reuters)—Brig. Gen. Alexander M. Haig Jr. visited the northern part of South Vietnam today to assess the military situation.

General Haig flew to Quang-tri city, a principal target of the North Vietnamese, and had talks with South Vietnamese military officials.

General Haig, second in command to Henry A. Kissinger, the President's national security adviser, arrived in Saigon Saturday.
