Expert Says Hue's Fall Would Doom the South

London

A leading British guer-rilla warfare expert said here last night that if North Vietnamese troops took the South Vietnam provincial capital of Hue. South Vietnam would probably collapse.

probably comapse. Sir Robert Thompson, a one-time adviser to Presi-dent Nixon on the Vietnam war, was speaking in a tele-vision interview on the Brit-ish Proceeding Corporaish Broadcasting Corporation.

Asked whether he thought it was the case that if Hue fell the Vietnam war would

be lost, he replied: "Yes, I think it is." "I think this would be such a demoralizing blow that South Vietnam would that South Vietnam would probably collapse," he added.
